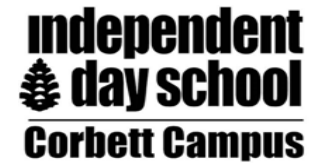

ACADEMY OF THE HOLY NAMES: 3319 W BAYSHORE BLVD (813) 839-5371

Take I-275 south to Howard/Armenia exit.

Take the second left, (Armenia Ave.), which is one way to the left, and go about one mile to the light at Kennedy Blvd.

Go right on Kennedy Blvd.

Then, go a short distance, and turn left onto MacDill Ave. (light).

Go about two miles until you go under the Crosstown Expressway.

The next light is the school crosswalk light.

Turn right at that light and that will take you into the school gym.

CARROLLWOOD DAY SCHOOL: 1515 W BEARSS AVE (813) 920-2288 (for Cross Country meets; try to get here after 3:30 p.m., if possible because otherwise, you will get in the dismissal crowd.)

We have two entrances off Bearss Ave. and either one is ok to enter and park (buses may have more room and be easier to park if you enter on the East side, which would be the closest to Florida Ave.)

You will see parking spaces as you come in...park where you can.

Meeting area will be north of the school.

TAMPA PREP SCHOOL: 625 N. BLVD (813) 251-8481

Take Dale Mabry south to the Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.

Take a left onto Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Blvd.

Right onto North Blvd.

The school is on the left

BERKELEY PREP SCHOOL: 4811 KELLY RD (813) 885-1673

Take Dale Mabry south to the Hillsborough Ave. exit.

Take a right onto Hillsborough Ave at the end of the ramp.

Left onto Kelly Rd (TJ Maxx and Mobil station on the corner).

The school is on the left
