## IDS SPORTS UPDATE

This past weekend the IDS Green and Purple Middle School Volleyball teams participated in the Indian Rocks Christian School Invitational Tournament. Sixteen schools brought strong teams to the event, leading to a very high level of competition. Both IDS teams were quite successful in their respective divisions. The Purple team took a fiercely contested 2<sup>nd</sup> place in the Gold division among 16 teams competing, with the final team winning by only two points in the final of three games. Our Green squad wrapped up their successful weekend leaving as winners of the Bronze division. The Purple team dominated their opponents, winning 200 points to their opponents' 112 prior to the championship match. Congratulations to Coach Dewey and Coach Starkey and their group of exceptional athletes on their performance.



## TECHNOLOGY UPDATE: VERY EXCITING!

IDS is making a huge change in technology in the next 2 months. Over the last 10 years our small computer network has grown from 50 computers with 1 server to over 500 computers with 10 servers. This increase also came with increased needs for software for all different levels of our students.



All this increase has caused heavy demands on the computers around campus and also created a need for high security protection from viruses and malware. This has created a severe drain on all end user computer resources and a need for a major shift in how we handle the distribution of software resources.

Xendesktop is our answer. All of the resource intensive applications will run on new servers which will speed up desktop login and usage speeds considerably.

Improvements will be seen by teachers and students alike including: login times cut from several minutes to under a minute and in some cases under 30 seconds; virus and malware issues will be reduced to a minimum, protecting our school computer network; students and teachers will be able to utilize their school software and data from home or anywhere they have an Internet connection off campus. We will also be using considerably less power in our class rooms because computers can be turned off at all times they are not in use as opposed to right now, where desktops run 24/7 in most cases. These are just some of the many exciting improvements. This big investment is due to the generosity of our families from the dollars raised by PFA and Annual Giving support.

# ATTENDANCE REMINDERS FOR A SUCCESSFUL SCHOOL YEAR FOR ALL IDSers

We take matters of attendance very seriously because we care about the safety and well-being of your children. Attendance is taken in homerooms at 8:00 am, and tardies and absences are reported to the office. To be accurate in our monitoring of attendance, we need your help in the following areas:



- 1. All students arriving after 8:00 am must sign in at the school office on the east side or west side before proceeding to class. Students will receive a pass to class. Students who are on-time get a great fresh start to the day.**
- 2. Parents need to call the school by 8:30 a.m. if their child(ren) will be absent that day, either leaving a message on the answering machine if they call before office staff arrives, or by talking directly with the receptionist. PARENTS MAY REQUEST HOMEWORK IF A STUDENT IS ABSENT FOR TWO OR MORE DAYS. Only after a request will homework be placed in the office by the end of the second day for collection by the parent.**
- 3. Parents also need to send in notes to the homeroom teacher (or make prior contact with office staff) if their child will need to leave school early, if there is to be a change in afternoon pick-up arrangements, or if they know in advance of an upcoming absence.**
- 4. All students departing before the end of the school day are required to check out at the east or west side office before leaving campus. Parents should respect the school's need to know the whereabouts of all students at all times.**
- 5. In order to insure the safety of all students, parents must give permission for their child(ren) to walk, ride a bike, or carpool home from school (see Appendix IV). You can obtain a form from the office to give your permission.**

**NOTE: It is important for the continuity of a child's education that classes be missed ONLY when absolutely necessary. Noon dismissal days are highly academically focused. Attendance is expected for all IDSers.**

**REMEMBER:** pick-up on the east side at Corbett Hall is at the front door ONLY. Please wait in line so we can maintain an orderly dismissal.

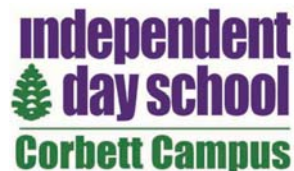

**CARROLLWOOD DAY SCHOOL:** 1515 W. Bearss Avenue: 920-2288
