EDU-NEWS AROUND CAMPUS



Each week we will attempt to give you a peek into some highlights around campus in and out of classrooms. There is so much to see and do at IDS, as people learn when they take one of "Joyce's two hour plus" Edu-Tours in and out of the classrooms. Below are some highlights that teachers are sharing.

MIDDLE SCHOOL TECHNOLOGY: Students are off to a great start in Technology class with our new technology guru, Mrs. Darina Glover-Russell and all of her brand new flat screen state of the art Dell computers. **Sixth and Seventh grade** students have been applying their computer knowledge by creating a dream vacation. They were given an allotment of \$5,000 to make this vacation special. Math, Technology techniques, and imagination were integrated to capture the interest of our students. During the project, students learned how to create a travel brochure using Microsoft Publisher and how to create basic formulas using Microsoft Excel. The formulas were created to help keep track of the students' money so they could stay within their budgets. Students explored the Internet to locate the perfect vacation spot, transportation prices, hotel prices and interesting facts about their vacation spot. Combining real life experiences with school knowledge taps into both right and left brain learning!

EIGHTH GRADE STUDENTS worked on a joint project with the Social Studies Department. Gaining even more expertise in PowerPoint presentations, they combined the research and presentation parts to bring "history alive" in their American History course. They also learned the difference between the terms "hyperlink" and "embed". **All middle school students** worked very hard to develop their own Electronic Portfolios. These portfolios will be used to showcase work that has been completed in all content areas as part of their work with the International Baccalaureate expectations. Students tapped into their creativity by designing a portfolio that represents themselves.

EAST-SIDE TECHNOLOGY with Mr. MEL: Matt Melnick reports, "We have moved into our Mac Book unit with almost all of the students." Last year Mr. Mel introduced Mac laptops to go along with his new flat screen Dell computers. Students in Pre-K through fifth grade learned to use both a PC and a Mac platform even at their early ages. All of our technology opportunities are a direct result of the amazing fundraising from our PFA and Annual Giving program. Everyone working together has brought these opportunities to our students, and our teachers make it all work for kids! On the east side, here is a peek into what has happened in the first five weeks of school in the computer room:



Kindergarten is learning how to take pictures of themselves with the built-in Mac camera using Photo Booth software. Upper Primary is learning how to organize thoughts and pictures while connecting with their classroom unit about Symbols using Comic Life software. Grades third through fourth are creating audio slideshow podcasts connecting with their Nifty Fifty Unit which teaches Prefixes, Root Words and Suffixes using Garage Band software, and Grade 5 is creating an audio slideshow podcast connecting with their Plural Nouns Unit using Garage Band software. Bravo Mr. Mel for linking and integrating technology content with classroom academic content.

MIDDLE SCHOOL TAKES THE SPANISH LANGUAGE FROM THE TEXT TO REAL LIFE OPPORTUNITIES! Students from IDS will welcome twelve students and two teachers from Lledó School in Castellon, Spain at the airport on Saturday morning October 4. These students represent our second opportunity to welcome middle schoolers to share culture and language together for three weeks. The leadership has visited IDS in the past, and they look forward to having their students get to know our students. The Lledó School is another very exciting private school from Spain that has adopted the IDS **M.O.R.E. Approach.**



Host parents and students from IDS met on Sunday evening, September 28th in the Laney Library to learn about the students from Lledó. They shared information about the visit and created an energy of excitement and anticipation. Our Spanish visitors will shadow in the Middle School classes where they will learn about the American family, culture and language – and we will learn from them! **As Sra. 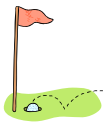

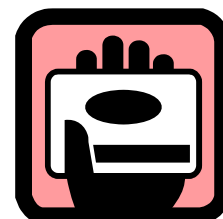
