## HOW TO REGISTER FOR TRIMESTER 1

### 1 – CHOOSE YOUR CLASSES-PAGES 6-7 & 10-12

Look through the class descriptions, Music-P.6, Dance-P.7, Art-P.10, Photography-P.11, Drama-P.12, and select the classes, including private and pair lessons, which interest you.

### 2 – CHECK THE MASTER SCHEDULE-PAGES 8-9

Times for all classes, music, dance, art and drama, are shown on the master schedule on pages 8-9. This schedule shows only class lessons. Private and pair lessons will be scheduled separately based on the availability of the teacher. Please contact Tom McColley at [csa@idsyes.com](mailto:csa@idsyes.com) to schedule all private and pair lessons. We offer lessons in art, dance, acting, piano, voice, guitar, woodwinds, brass, and strings.

### 3 – FILL OUT REGISTRATION FORMS – PAGES 15-16

Fill out the Student Information Form on P. 15 and the Registration Form on P. 16. The registration form includes a line for each class offered by the Community School of the Arts. If you register for Class Piano, you must fill in the day of the week you want to attend. Students enrolling for private and pair lessons should fill in the subject under "Class Name" i.e., piano, drawing, dance. Private and pair students can indicate preferred days and times, remembering that lesson times are subject to the availability of the teacher.

### 4 – TURN IN REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Please turn your forms in early. Classes fill up quickly. All classes must be paid in full prior to the first session.

### 5 - ATTEND YOUR FIRST CLASS OR LESSON

Classes begin the week of September 6, 2009. If you sign up for a class lesson, please come to the first class. We will only contact you if the class is full. If you sign up for private and pair lessons, we will contact you with the day and time for your lesson. ## STUDY OPTIONS

**PRIVATE LESSONS:** The one-on-one contact between teacher and student in the traditional private lesson allows the instruction to be catered to the student's unique needs. This is the best choice for motivated students at any level of experience. Private lessons are scheduled once each week for thirty minutes. One-hour lessons are available for advanced students. (\$360 per trimester)

**PAIR LESSONS:** Two students and a teacher meet for thirty minutes once each week in pair lessons. This arrangement offers the flexibility of allocating part of the lesson to each student, working with both students together, and having the students coach each other under the direct supervision of a teacher. The social aspect of pair lessons is motivating to many students. (\$250 for each student per trimester)

**CLASS LESSONS:** Small groups of students work with the teacher and each other in group lessons. The teacher sets the pace for each student. Older, more advanced students build their mastery by coaching younger, less experienced students. This provides an ideal, introductory experience for many students. (\$150 per trimester)

**Tap I, II & III:** Become acquainted with great music and lots of fun with this highly rhythmic, foot-focused dance form. Tap I is for beginners. Tap II & III builds on the vocabulary studied in Tap I and requires one year of tap training or permission from Mrs. Ferlita. Tap I, Wednesday, 5:00-5:55, Tap II, Tuesday, 4:00-4:55, Tap III, Wednesday, 5:00-5:55, \$150.
